

Lesson Plan Requirements

1. Lesson plans should be turned in weekly before the start of class on Monday morning. Each campus principal sets their deadline.
2. TEKS must be identified for each lesson. At least one of the ELPS must be identified.
3. A lesson frame written in the We will/I will format must be articulated for each day and posted in the room. Lesson frames are to be written in the 2 + 2 + 1 style.
 - 2 (talk or write) + 2 (summarize or compare/contrast) + 1 (every day)
 - Teachers should have an emergency back-up close ready in the event they do not get completely through the lesson for the day. Example:
What was the most _____ thing we learned today?
 - Core teachers should attempt to use a written close at least 60% of the time when grade level appropriate (3 – 12).
 - Performance classes (fine arts, CTE, etc.) will use a spoken close most often.
