<p>11+ years</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choices in 7-10 or ● Serving as a teacher-leader, mentor teacher, or instructional coach, and being observed in that role <p><i>“Upon mutual agreement with the evaluator, Permanent teachers employed for ten years with the district and having received three (3) consecutive positive evaluations shall be formally evaluated by the Principal or his/her designee in writing on District forms at least every five (5) years.”</i></p>
