I know many of you are excited to purchase school supplies. Students are asked to bring the following supplies:

- Pencil box or pouch to keep at school
- Extra pencils
- Extra eraser(s)
- 3x3 stick notes
- Fine tip dry erase marker(s)
- 2 or more black fine and ultra-fine tip black Sharpies (We use these a lot!)
- Refillable water bottle (Please label with your name.)
- Other supplies that are optional if students prefer to have their own instead of sharingmarkers, glue sticks, scissors (Please label with your name.)
- Students will be provided with a 1½ inch or 2 inch binder, crayons, colored pencils, a folder, and a daily planner that will go inside their binder. Students may purchase their own 1½ or 2 inch binder if they choose.
