



ADMISSIONS

Information for Transfer Applicants to Grades 10-12

1. Transfer student applications accepted February through August.
2. Complete and submit application with the \$65 non-refundable application fee. Payment may be made online with a credit card after the online application is complete.
3. Request the following required items via your online checklist:
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation from counselor/instructors from current academic year. Requests must be sent to the teacher's professional email address and, if possible, written with school letterhead. All letters must be uploaded directly by the teacher and NOT through the applicant's family
 - Administrator form
 - Semester report card(s) and/or transcript beginning at grade 9 through the most recent academic semester/trimester
4. Upon receipt of completed application and grade verification, the Director of Admissions will schedule a family interview.
5. Completed application and records will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee to determine if our school can meet the student's needs. If the candidate is deemed qualified, he/she will be placed in a wait pool. As openings occur, students will be admitted from the wait pool of applicants.
6. Upon acceptance, a non-refundable tuition fee of \$1,000.00 is required. This payment is applied as a credit toward tuition.
7. Official transcripts will be requested after acceptance and official enrollment.

Shadow Days

Beginning April 15, 2026, transfer applicants may schedule a shadow visit at Jesuit High School. Shadow visits begin at 7:45 am and end at 1:45 pm on school days (excluding Tuesdays). Applicants are paired with a student Ambassador for the first five classes of the day, plus lunch. Please plan on either bringing a sack lunch or \$6 to buy lunch. To schedule a shadow day, please call the Admissions office at 503-291-5423. Transfer applicants are required to follow the school dress code on shadow day visits.
