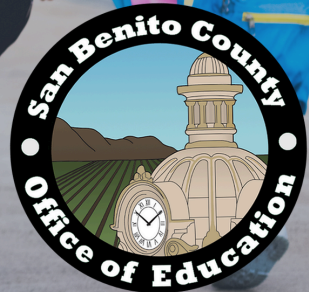

Access to Learning Support

After school tutorial service either online or in-person; summer enrichment programs and transition activities, school supplies, reading materials, and school transportation



Access to Rest

Basic Access to Homeless Education and Community Support
Students experiencing homelessness and their families may be eligible for up to five nights of hotel accommodations, based on availability. Families must be registered in school and meet McKinney-Vento eligibility requirements. We will also connect families with local community agencies for additional support and resources, which may be available based on individual needs.



Access to Health, Self-Care and Food

Dental care referral, vision and hearing, hygiene kit, food, and other personal care items/clothing



Access to Training

Parent trainings and Staff Professional Development to heighten the understanding, identifying and removing the barriers to education
