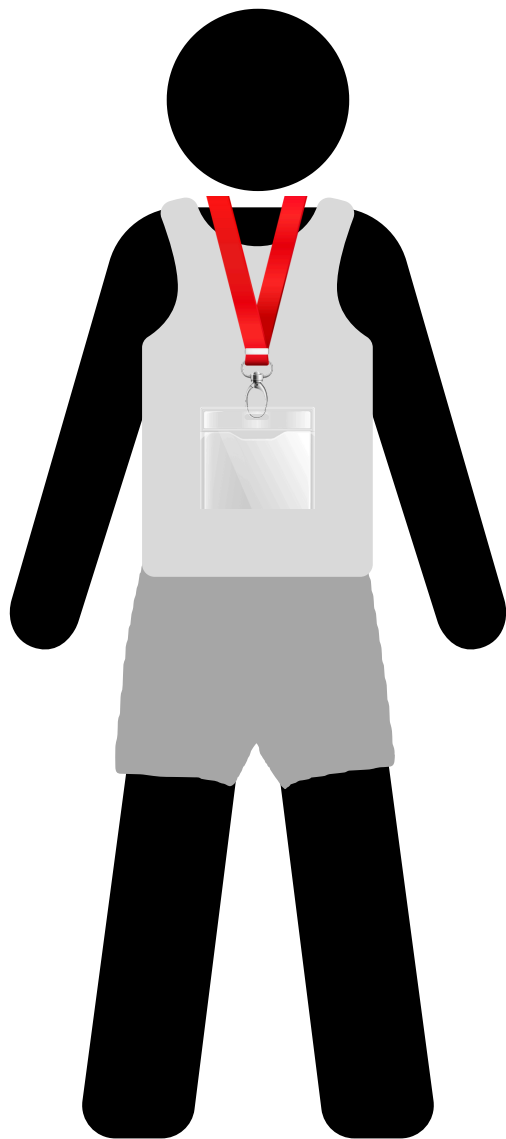


Image illustrates the areas of the body that must be covered at all times to adhere to the established dress code.

ID Badges	All students must wear a student ID badge, visible, on school-approved lanyards, during the instructional day.
Head Coverings	Hats and other headwear, including hoodies, beanies, durags, bonnets, etc., are not to be worn at school with the exception of: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A cap or hat that is part of a uniform worn at a school activity• For religious or medical purposes• Designated campus spirit days
Tops	Must not reveal underclothing, midsection, torso, chest or back. Students are not to wear clothing that is revealing, strapless, spaghetti-strap, backless, low cut, or short. Tank tops must be at least 3 fingers in width.
Bottoms	Must fit at the waist or upper hip. Must not reveal underclothing and must be no shorter than 1 inch above the fingertip when hands are placed at the sides. Note: Sleepwear, including pajamas and slippers are not permitted.
Graphics (on clothing)	Should reflect a positive image of the school and contribute to a distraction-free learning environment. No drug references, alcohol, cigarettes, weapons, offensive language, or sexual connotations/images.
