ID Badges	All students must wear a student ID badge, visible, on school-approved lanyards, during the instructional day.
Head Coverings	Hats and other headwear, including hoodies, beanies, durags, bonnets, etc., are not to be worn at school with the exception of: • A cap or hat that is part of a uniform worn at a school activity • For religious or medical purposes • Designated campus spirit days
Tops	Must not reveal underclothing, midsection, torso, chest or back. Students are not to wear clothing that is revealing, strapless, spaghetti-strap, backless, low cut, or short. Tank tops must be at least 3 fingers in width.
Bottoms	Must fit at the waist or upper hip. Must not reveal underclothing and must be no shorter than 1 inch above the fingertip when hands are placed at the sides. Note: Sleepwear, including pajamas and slippers are not permitted.
Graphics (on clothing)	Should reflect a positive image of the school and contribute to a distraction-free learning environment. No drug references, alcohol, cigarettes, weapons, offensive language, or sexual connotations/images.
