Dear Cheltenham Community -

We are committed to keeping you informed and wanted to share the latest developments on the Cheltenham High School stadium complex project. While challenges earlier this summer caused delays, our focus remains steadfast: to provide as many opportunities as possible for our student-athletes to compete at home this season.

The following progress has been made since our last update. Underground water utility work from the high school to the stadium is nearing completion, clearing the way for full-scale excavation. Demolition of the concession stand and bleachers is complete, and major excavation for stormwater systems and additional utility work within the stadium is set to begin next week. We remain committed to exploring every opportunity with our contractor to compress the schedule, with the current completion target still projected for the first or second week of October.

As a reminder, some home varsity football games have been relocated to a neutral site for this season. Neutral sites will be reserved as a contingency for additional home games if the updated timeline is not met. Additionally, all junior varsity games will be played away. Rather than playing all varsity games on the road, the following contests will now be hosted at Wissahickon High School (521 Houston Road, Ambler, PA 19002):

- Friday, August 29 at 7 p.m. vs. Central Bucks East
- Friday, September 19 at 7 p.m. vs. Bensalem (Homecoming)

We know how important this project is to the community and we will keep you updated along the way. We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience or frustration this may cause and appreciate your patience and flexibility during this time. Thank you for your continued support.
