

**PERMISSION FOR STUDENT TO SELF-CARRY OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATION**  
**(High School Students Only)**

In order for a high school student to self-carry over the counter medication at school, parents/guardians must complete and submit this form to the principal, or their designee, of the school the student attends. Students who are in high school may only carry the following approved over-the-counter medications: **acetaminophen (Tylenol), ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) , antacid tablets (Calcium Carbonate) and lactase enzyme (Lactaid).**

Students must adhere to the following:

- The student may only carry the dosage to be used at school for one school day/activity.
- Medication must be in original container or package.
- The student may not share the medication with another student/person.

Permission to carry medication will be granted for the current school year only and must be renewed at the beginning of the next school year.
