

Entrance Procession

We begin the celebration of the Mass with the entrance procession. The procession fosters unity and sets the tone for the Mass. The procession itself reminds us that we are pilgrims on this earth, walking with and to God. Biblically, it reminds us of many processions throughout salvation history including Israel processing with the ark of the covenant, the entrance into Jerusalem (Palm Sunday), the road to Calvary and the road to Emmaus where the risen Jesus revealed the Scriptures and the Eucharist to His disciples.

The Procession is led by the crucifix, representing God's presence and reminding us that it is this Sacrifice that is made present at Mass and two candles, representing God's light and love which illuminates our path on this pilgrimage. Historically, the candles served to literally light the way when the early Church was heavily persecuted and Mass was celebrated underground in the catacombs. Following them is the Book of the Gospels which is held slightly elevated and placed on the altar demonstrating its place as the Word of God, Christ Himself present and speaking to us.



### ACA 2025 – SACRED HEART PARISH REBATE PROJECT

This two-story mid-century modern brick building, situated along 14th Street, was constructed in 1955 during the establishment of the church. Initially designed to accommodate parish offices, gathering spaces and living quarters for our priests, it continues to fulfill a vital role today, serving as office space, as well as housing our Youth Ministry Room and Parish Hall.

The flat roof has outlived its intended lifespan and has faced several weather challenges, including damage from a recent windstorm. Taking proactive steps to replace the roof now will help ensure the building remains structurally sound and prevent any potential problems down the line. This investment will protect the building's integrity for years to come. Any gifts received over our ACA goal of \$197,500 will be returned to the parish to help fund replacement of the roof.
