




Join the 9:00 AM Sacred Heart Choir

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ we are also starting to wrap up the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal here at Sacred Heart. Each one of us makes up the body of Christ, and all gifts matter! If you have already given, we are incredibly grateful. If you have not made your contribution, we ask you to prayerfully consider making a gift today. To date, 154 parish families have responded generously with a gift. We have currently received pledges and gifts in the amount of \$105,827 which is 54% of our goal. Any money we raise above our goal will support our parish project to help fund the replacement of the roof of the original parish offices along 14th Street. ACA 2025 – SACRED HEART PARISH REBATE PROJECT

This two-story mid-century modern brick building, situated along 14th Street, was constructed in 1955 during the establishment of the church. Initially designed to accommodate parish offices, gathering spaces and living quarters for our priests, it continues to fulfill a vital role today, serving as office space, as well as housing our Youth Ministry Room and Parish Hall.

The flat roof has outlived its intended lifespan and has faced several weather challenges, including damage from a recent windstorm. Taking proactive steps to replace the roof now will help ensure the building remains structurally sound and prevent any potential problems down the line. This investment will protect the building's integrity for years to come. Any gifts received over our ACA goal of \$197,500 will be returned to the parish to help fund replacement of the roof.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH—COMMUNITY EVENTS

Lay Ministry Opportunity Eastside Deanery Pastoral Care Team

To support the on-call Priests in the Eastside Deanery, we have a small group of Lay Ministers who take the initial calls from hospital nurses and Chaplains, adult care facilities, a patient's family member, or the patient themselves. The Lay Minister takes all of the necessary information for the on-call Priest, and then calls the Priest who is scheduled for that part of the Deanery. Each Lay Minister covers the same hours each week. The "shifts" are 9 AM to 4 PM, and 4 PM to 9 AM the following day, seven days a week. The Ministry is currently short one Lay Minister. We need someone to cover the Wednesday night and Thursday night shifts. 
