

## Behold the Lamb Quick Weekly Lessons on the Sacred Liturgy

Having made the Sign of the Cross, the Priest extends his hands and says *The Greeting*. This second part of the Introductory Rite continues to gather the people of God and prepares us to enter the Sacred Liturgy worthily and well. *The Greeting* has three options which the Priest chooses from, all of which have the sentiment of the third: "The Lord be with you." This greeting reminds us of the greetings of the apostles—whom our bishops and priests today directly succeed from—in their letters to the early Church. It is also our comfort as we humble ourselves before God as we remember His promise that He, our hope and our strength, is with us always (Matt 28:20). Finally, it continues to reveal to us the mystery of the Body of Christ as it makes manifest the words of Jesus, "for where two or three are gathered in my name," which we just invoked, "there am I in the midst of them." (Matt 18:20).


## Join the 9:00 AM Sacred Heart Choir

#### Eastside Deanery Pastoral Care Team
