#### Restraint and Seclusion

RP1: July 1-December 31- RP2: January 1-June 30

#### Restraint

- Mechanical
  - · Defined by U.S. Department of Education
  - The use of any device or equipment to restrict a student's freedom of movement.
  - Does not include devices implemented by trained school personnel, or utilized by a student that have been prescribed by an appropriate medical or related services professional and are used for the specific and approved purposes for which the devices were designed such as:
    - Adaptive mobility devices
    - Vehicle safety restraints
    - Medical immobilization restraints
    - Orthopedically prescribed devices

#### Physical

- · Defined by NJ state law
- Use of a personal restriction that immobilizes or reduces the ability of a student to move all or a portion of his or her body

#### Seclusion

- Defined by NJ state law
- The involuntary confinement of a student alone in a room or area from which the student is physically prevented from leaving
- Does not include a timeout

#### Timeout

 A behavior management technique that involves the monitored separation of a student in a nonlocked setting, and is implemented for the purpose of calming
