

CLASSROOM DRESS CODE Quick Guide all students grades prek-12

SHIRTS & OUTER GARMENTS

Navy Blue and White are our district shirt colors.



Collar Oxford (long or short sleeve) button up

Peter Pan Collar (long or short sleeve)

(long or short sleeve) white button up blouse for elementary girls

Light jackets or sweatshirts <u>without a hood</u>, shall be solid color of navy, white, gray, black, or school approved color and may be allowed for indoor wear, but must have a regulation uniform shirt worn underneath at all times.



solid sweatshirts

Students are allowed to wear school-sponsored organization jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters.

full and quarter length zip jackets

(no hoods)

Long or short sleeve, polo style (pull over) or oxford style (button up) white or navy are allowed. Each school shall have an option of a school color shirt to wear.

Sleeveless, turtle neck, midriff, or shirts with zippers are not allowed.

Solid white, black, navy, or school-approved long or short sleeved shirt may be worn under regular uniform shirts. Thermal underwear and turtlenecks are not allowed.

SHORTS, PANTS, SKIRTS, & JUMPERS



Khaki or navy color twill "slacks" with or without pleats, with or without pockets, with or without belt loops (if belt loops, students <u>must</u> wear a belt) will be worn at the waist line.

Bell bottom, cargo, safari, carpenter, wind suit, or sweat pants are not allowed.

Shorts, skirts, skorts, & jumpers may be worn K-12 in khaki or navy color twill ONLY, with length being no more than 3 inches above the knee.

cardigans

Students may wear solid khaki, black, white, gray or navy colored leggings under jumper/skirts.



All bottoms must be of appropriate size. No sagging, oversized, or wide leg pants shall be worn.



Remember, school uniforms must:

- · be solid in color
- fit properly for normal daily activity
- be clean and free of tears/rips/holes
- have tucked shirt tails if requested by principal

BELTS, SHOES, & ACCESSORIES

Belts must be the appropriate length for the student's waist size. Belt buckles must be plain, standard style.



Belts are MANDATORY for Middle School, Junior High, and High School students when wearing bottoms with belt loops. Elementary students are encouraged to wear a belt.

All shoes shall consist of a closed back and front.



No sandals, wedged soles, platforms, high heels, "crocs," slippers, shower shoes, flip flops, moccasins or knee-high shoes shall be allowed.

Students may only wear stud piercings in the ear.

No head wear shall be worn on campus or bus, except when a medical condition or religious belief so warrents. Necessary outdoor headgear is allowed in inclement weather.



Students may wear heavy coats or jackets of any color or style outdoors and on school buses; however, said coats/jackets may not have inappropriate insignia, logos, or language. Dusters or trench coats are not allowed.

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Heavy coats/jackets/hats must be removed upon entering a school building. No hoodies allowed on school campuses or busses.
