District Requirements for CPR Certification

The following job classifications are **required** to take CPR:

- 5 Hour Yard Aide
- Cafeteria Manager
- Campus Security Supervisor
- Cooks/Bakers (Voluntary, but are timecarded)
- ELOP Coordinator
- ELOP Mentor
- ELOP/ACES Managers
- Head Custodians
- School Nurse
- Licensed Health Service Technician (LHST)
- PE Teachers
- Pre-K Staff (Instructor, Aide and Associate)
- School Secretaries
- School Site Clerks
- SDC Teachers (MMSN, ESN, BIC)
- Behavioral Intervention Assistant (BIA)
- Paraeducators II and III (Includes Para II - Health)
- Transportation Aide
- Transporter
- *Coaches - (HR works with the Recreation Coordinator for training set up. Timecards are not provided. Coaches paid via stipend.)

Site/Department Administrator Must Request and Approve:

- Junior High Music Teachers (Check with VAPA Administrator for approval)
- Search Team / First Aid Team

- Transportation - Bus Driver
- Other job classifications per Administrator request

The site/department budget code will be used for timecards.

CPR certification classes are available to all District employees in other job classifications. However, they will not be compensated(timecarded). For liability reasons, we cannot offer CPR classes to friends and/or family members of District employees. It is a collaborative responsibility of the employee and HSW to track expiration dates.
