I. Introduction to Dual Credit at RCS

III. How to Request a Transcript from Jessup University from a Dual Credit Course

1. After a student successfully passes their Dual Credit course, and they want to receive their transcript, they will go to the "National Student Clearinghouse Transcript Services" to request it: <https://tsorder.studentclearinghouse.org/school/select>
2. The school they should write in is "William Jessup University," or it may be "Jessup University" (**NOT** RCS or Redwood Christian Schools) and fill-in the steps that will follow.
