Dress Code guidelines – 2025-2026



Students are expected to be dressed for success at CEEMS at all times. It is mandatory at Clyde Erwin that all students adhere to the dress code guidelines that are set each day. Most retail stores in the area and many online vendors sell the items that are needed. All clothing and shoes must be clean and in good repair.

Note – if a student comes to school out of uniform, a parent will be contacted to bring a change of clothes. Repeated offences will result in a school-based consequence for the student. The dress code policy was an agreement when accepting their seat at CEEMS.

Shirts and blouses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid white or solid navy blue polo shirt or dress shirt – no logo</li> <li>• Long or short sleeves</li> <li>• Must have a collar and visible if wearing a sweater/sweatshirt</li> <li>• Button or snap front (for blouses)</li> <li>• Must be tucked in at all times</li> </ul> <p>***Solid white undershirts may be worn however the sleeves must not exceed the length of the shirt</p> <p>***Undergarments are not to be visible through shirts</p>
Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, dresses, and rompers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid tan or solid navy blue</li> <li>• No denim or corduroy</li> <li>• No leggings or jeggings as pants</li> <li>• Belts are to be worn if bottoms have belt loops</li> <li>• All bottoms must be as long as a cupped hand when arms are extended at your side</li> <li>• Sagging is not allowed. Bottoms are to be worn at the natural waistline.</li> </ul>
Belts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid brown, black, or navy blue with non-decorative buckles</li> <li>• Must be worn through belt loops</li> </ul>
Socks, pantyhose, and stockings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Socks can be solid white, solid navy blue, or solid black</li> <li>• Socks must be visible – no ‘no show socks’</li> <li>• Females may wear natural colored, navy blue, or white tights/stockings</li> </ul>
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid brown, black, or navy blue shoes</li> <li>• Sneakers are acceptable</li> <li>• Shoelaces must be tied (not tucked in)</li> <li>• No heeled shoes, boots, or slippers</li> <li>• Tennis shoes MUST be worn on PE days</li> </ul>
Sweaters, cardigans, sweatshirts, vests, and blazers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Solid white, navy blue, or tan</li> <li>• No hoods</li> <li>• Collars of shirts must remain visible</li> </ul> <p>***Hoodies, jackets, and coats may be worn to and from the building but will not be permitted to be worn throughout the day. If your student is cold natured, consider providing an appropriate sweater for throughout the day.</p>
CEEMS swag / spirit wear	<p>All CEEMS students are able to wear CEEMS swag (ie. school shirts, sweatshirts, etc) any day of the week as long as the other uniform guidelines are met.</p> <p>***Swag items will be available for purchase at the school.</p>
Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Headbands may be worn but must not be distracting (ie. No cat ears)</li> <li>• No other headwear will be allowed (ie. bandanas, sleepwear, etc)</li> </ul>
