# Classroom Insights:

## Blue Homework Folder

The blue homework folders will be our main source of communication. Please remove all papers and return the folder daily. We will also use the folder to communicate with you individually about other topics as needed. Any correspondence should go inside the folder. We will check the folders each morning. Please do not send stray notes/money in students' hands or bookbags. These items tend to get lost between home and school. Please utilize the folder! It is very important that your child bring this to school daily!

### Money:

If you need to send your child to school with any money, please make sure it is placed in the blue homework folder. All money should be in a labeled envelope with the student's name and purpose. Please do not send your child to school with unidentified money. Thank you for your assistance!

### Lunch:

Our class will eat lunch each day at 10:20 am. Students may either purchase a school lunch or bring a lunchbox from home. The monthly lunch menu is posted on the school's website. Take time to talk with your child about the daily choices and help them make a choice or send something from home if it is something they will not eat. Please do not put your child's daily snack in their lunchbox. They think that it is lunch and can be very confusing for our young learners. You can send a Dojo message to clarify lunch if needed.

### Ice cream:

Ice cream will be sold on Fridays ONLY during your child's lunch time. Ice cream costs \$1.00. Please be sure to send ice cream money in your child's folder and label it. The teachers will help students purchase at lunch. Students will lose any loose money and get upset when they do not have their money to purchase ice cream. Thank you for your understanding and support!

### Class Dojo:

Our school uses Class Dojo as a communication tool. This will be the easiest way to get in touch with your child's teacher during the school day. We will post pictures, important updates, and important dates for families to remember. Students can earn Dojo points for positive behavior and lose points if any unsafe or disruptive behaviors occur. Your child's Dojo points can give you great insight into their behavior at school. Please check Dojo daily for updates and communicate with your

child's teacher. We are a team, and communication is important. We look forward to working with your family to make this year great!

### **Transportation Change:**

ALL transportation changes MUST be handwritten and signed by a parent. You may not email, Dojo, or call with transportation changes. This is for the safety of our students. Thank you for your cooperation!

### **Homework:**

Students will receive a sight word list that will be kept in their blue daily communication folder. Daily homework expectations are that students practice sight words (new words and continuous review of previously taught words). We will provide fun, hands-on learning activities that your family can use to practice sight words. Practicing sight words daily directly corresponds to our school's reading goals for the year! Unfinished daily work may also be sent home as homework. We need your support at home to help our learners reach their goals! Additionally, students will receive a homework packet each Monday. It is due the following Monday.

### **Behavior:**

We are proud to be a PBIS school (Positive Behavioral Intervention and Support) school. We celebrate students' making positive choices. As a school, we will reward students' behavior by giving points on Class Dojo. Students with 15 points or higher of positive behavior points will receive prizes each week!

Students can earn points for participating, raising their hands, being safe, being organized, being accountable, and being respectful. However, students can also lose points for these same areas if inappropriate behavior persists in the classroom. We will give students multiple reminders to correct behavior before we take a Dojo point or message you on Dojo. In our classroom, we tie all behavior back to the school's SOAR expectations. (Safe, Accountable, Organized, and Respectful). By encouraging all students in our classroom and at home, we can ensure that we provide a positive, safe learning environment for all students.

### Snack Time:

Students will have a quick snack time each day. Students are required to provide their own, healthy snack that can be eaten in 10 minutes or less. (Ex: fruit, baked chips, etc...) Please **do not** send juice boxes, soda, or other sugary drinks. However, water bottles may be kept in the classroom in the student's cubby. Please reach out to me on ClassDojo if you would like to donate a snack for our class!

### Rest Time:

We do not nap in kindergarten! Please help ensure your child is prepared to learn each day by going to bed early each night. Students will be tired after a long day of learning and fun!
