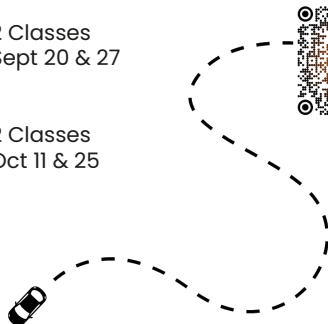

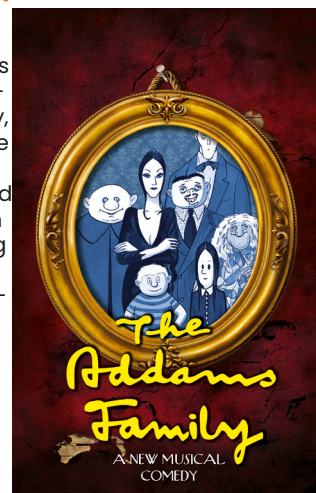

## POLICY AND PROCEDURES

### REGISTRATION DEADLINES:

### ENROLLMENT DEADLINES:

Deadline for classes is either two (2) days or seven (7) days prior to the start of class unless otherwise noted. Please check the link above for the class registration deadline. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Many classes fill quickly, and instructors may need to order supplies; prompt registration helps ensure you will get in the class. It also helps avoid the disappointment of cancelling class due to low enrollment, only to find that last-minute registrations would have filled the class. \*\*Please note that only registered and paid participants may attend the class. We kindly ask that children and non-registered guests not attend.

### PAYMENT:

Class fees must be paid in full at time of registration. We accept Visa, Discover, MasterCard, American Express, ACH payments, and cash or check by mail or in person.

### SENIOR ADULT DISCOUNT:

Senior adults receive 10% discount at time of registration.

### CANCELLATIONS:
