

**Online Day Plan – Franklin Monroe Local Schools 2025-2026**

In the event of school closure beyond the number of negotiated calamity days, Franklin Monroe Local Schools will add days to the end of the school year or on predetermined days on the school calendar to make up the time for the missed days.

Therefore, Franklin Monroe will not utilize online learning days to make up lost instructional time due to school closure.

In-person learning days ensure teacher-directed synchronous learning in which the teacher and students are interacting in real time.

Attendance for any days added to the end of the school year or on predetermined dates on the school calendar will be documented in the same manner as all regularly scheduled days.

By adding days to the end of the school year or on predetermined dates on the school calendar, Franklin Monroe Local Schools will ensure equitable access to quality instruction, including meeting the needs of students with disabilities, English learners, and other vulnerable student populations.

Franklin Monroe Local Schools will notify staff, students, and parents of any days added to the end of the school year or on predetermined dates on the school calendar by one or more of the following: automated calling system, website updates, written correspondence, electronic correspondence.

Internet connectivity and technology will be available to all students during any days added to the end of the school year or on predetermined dates on the school calendar in the same manner as all regularly scheduled days.

Information on contacting staff members on any days added to the end of the school year or on predetermined dates on the school calendar is posted on the district website (staff members' school email addresses and contact information for the elementary and MS/HS offices).
