School Runner Race Entry Fees:

\$12 per individual runner (includes park pass if in school transportation)

Community Runner Race Entry Fees:

\$15 per individual fun run entry (children 4 and under are free with family)

\$20 per individual runner in community 2 mile race

The top 20 runners in each division will receive medals. No team scores will be kept. All medals will be presented at 7:15 PM at the Garner Pavilion on the dance slab. Participants will be recognized by place, not race times. Coaches or parents are responsible for timing their own athletes. **NEW TEAM AWARDS**– Top teams in both performance and participation in each race will be recognized this year!

Community Awards:
