- Each family is asked to fill out the “Application of Education Benefits” form. This confidential form is used to determine some of Lakeview’s funding. Additionally, it is used to determine if your family qualifies for free or reduced lunch rate. If you have questions about the form, please feel free to discuss the form with Mrs. Karen Meiners.
- We’ve enclosed a school calendar for your convenience. Please note the early out dates and holidays. Additionally, school attendance is crucial for your child’s success. All students need a parent/guardian to call or email your absences for sickness or appointments. No student will leave without consent.
