Student Supply List: 2025-2026

Students will need to bring the following supplies to ALL or specific classes, as indicated:

Supplies for using across ALL Core Classes:

- Colored Pencils
- Traditional #2 Pencils—Students need enough for the whole year in ALL classes and may be asked to turn in a certain quantity to some teachers—Writing (50), Reading, E. Hemisphere, Math, and Science
EX: Amazon Pre-sharpened Wood-Cased pencils, 150 pack, approx. \$16
- 2 x handheld pencil sharpeners (one for regular pencils, one for colored pencils)
- Pens (blue or black only please)
- Highlighters (at least a 4-pack)
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue Sticks
