




# **Behavior Expectations**

A behavior matrix is a tool used to clarify and communicate expected behaviors, both positive and negative, across various

settings within a school or classroom. Its primary purpose is to establish a common understanding of expectations, guide interventions for misbehavior, and promote positive student behavior. We will continue to utilize the ROAR Matrix that is already implemented at GBES.

For additional clarity, please see the the purpose of a behavior matrix:

### 1. Clarifying Expectations:

### • School-wide:

A school-wide behavior matrix outlines expected behaviors in various school settings, such as hallways, cafeterias, and playgrounds.

### • Classroom:

Classroom matrices focus on behaviors specific to the classroom environment, such as during lessons, transitions, and independent work.

### Positive Emphasis:

The matrix typically emphasizes positive behaviors and provides specific examples of how to meet those expectations.

### 2. Guiding Interventions:

• Tiered Approach:

Behavior matrices can be part of a tiered system of interventions, where different levels of support are provided based on the severity of the misbehavior.

- **Consistency:** The matrix ensures consistent application of expectations and interventions across staff members and settings, promoting a fair and equitable approach.
- **Data Collection:** Some matrices include sections for collecting data on specific behaviors, helping educators identify trends and adjust interventions.

### 3. Promoting Positive Behavior

• Teaching:

The matrix can be used to teach students about expectations and reinforce positive behaviors.

Self-Regulation:

By clearly outlining expectations, the matrix can help students develop self-regulation skills and make positive choices.

• Positive School Culture:

A well-implemented behavior matrix contributes to a positive school culture by fostering a sense of community, safety, and shared responsibility.
