July 8, 2025, Meeting Minutes

Lucas Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by Tracy Flynn and seconded by Jim Olecki.

Lucas Taylor, Jim Olecki, Lenny Evans, Diane Witko, Tracy Flynn, Jay Wescott and Jasper DeFazio were present at the meeting.

Treasurer's Report-

- Diane reported a current balance of \$14,678.64. Diane noted that the taxes for year, 2024, have been filed on May 31.
- Yearly audit paperwork was delivered to Jim Olecki.
- Jim O. delivered cash for a couple chicken dinners sold post golf outing to Diane W. Gross receipts for the golf outing are \$10,454 and net profit for the outing is \$5,382.26; an increase of \$289.08.
- Diane W. noted that the T- sponsorship receipt decreased from \$2100 to \$1700. Lucas T. noted that 'Thank You' letters are prepared and being sent to all T-sponsors.
- Diane informed the group that she received four passes to Roba- Lakeland Orchard and Cidery. The passes will be saved for next year's golf outing.
- Jasper D. noted he became aware that there is a new \$7.00, yearly registration update charge, for all Pa. businesses (S, C, LLCs, Non-profits, etc.) Tracy F., checking the internet, was able to clarify that this is most likely for all businesses not active that do not file yearly tax returns, etc.
