Dear Parents/Staff Members

An asbestos management plan for our facility was developed and includes this notification letter, education and training of our employees, and a set of plans and procedures designed to minimize the disturbance of the asbestos-containing material, and plans for regular surveillance of the asbestos-containing materials.

A copy of the asbestos management plan is available for your inspection in our administrative office during regular office hours. Inquiries regarding the plan should be directed to the Designated Person (Dan Duenwald). As we complete response actions and preventive measures are conducted or completed, and at least annually, you will be notified of any changes in the amount and condition of asbestos-containing material in the school building.

The asbestos-containing building materials are required to be kept under surveillance. The Designated Person will conduct the semi-annual surveillances. In the summer of 2024 Dan Duenwald SD License #9711 re-inspected the school building as required by A.H.E.R.A. The Arlington School District was found to be in compliance with A.H.E.R.A. 763.94 regulations.

We plan on taking whatever steps are necessary to insure your children and our employees have a healthy, safe environment in which to learn and work. The only asbestos remaining in the school building is the floor tile in various areas of the Elementary Building, and ceiling tile in a few small areas of the building. All of these areas are safely encapsulated as required by law.

There are no scheduled changes that would impact the 2025-26 school year.
