In the Learn phase, your coach will share strategies and ideas to help you reach your goal. You'll have the chance to see these strategies in action, adapt them to your style, and work together to refine your approach.

In the Improve phase, you'll try out the new strategies with your students while your coach helps track progress and offers feedback. Together, you'll review what's working, date data, make adjustments, and keep building toward success.
