



6th Grade Behavior Contract



Dear Toro Families -

Sixth-grade students will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities throughout the year, including field trips, end-of-quarter and end-of-year celebrations, Field Day, and dances. To participate in these activities, students must consistently meet both classroom and school behavior expectations at Union Park.

Students will become **ineligible** to participate in activities if they:

- Receive **one major behavioral infraction**
- Accumulate **three minor behavior infractions** within a quarter.

Certain behaviors will result in **automatic exclusion** from activities, including but not limited to:

- Inappropriate Chromebook use
- Bullying or harassment
- Physical aggression toward another student or adult
- Threats of any kind
- Actions such as throwing food or mocking disabilities

Each quarter offers a **fresh opportunity** to participate. **Major behavior infractions from a previous quarter will not carry over** into the next quarter's eligibility, except for the **end-of-year middle school dance**. Any student who receives an office referral at any time during the semester (August–December or January–May) will not be eligible to attend the middle school end-of-year dance.

If a student becomes ineligible for an event, they will be given an alternative academic assignment aligned to the Arizona College and Career Ready Standards (AZCCRS).

Please note:

- **Refunds will not be available** for any paid field trips or activities if a student becomes ineligible due to behavior, illness, or other absence.
