

ANWSD CHILDCARE PROGRAM AIDE

➤ PURPOSE:

The Afterschool staff is responsible for providing safe and developmentally appropriate care for the children enrolled in the program while following all policies and procedures of the license and district.

➤ SCOPE:

The Afterschool staff will be responsible for planning and implementing a program to care for children. They must ensure the safety of the children enrolled in care. The Afterschool staff will be respectful of children and parents, and ensure that equipment and facilities are clean, safe, and well maintained.

➤ RESPONSIBILITIES:

DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM FOR ENROLLED CHILDREN

- Plan and implement activities to meet the physical, emotional, intellectual and social needs of the children in the program.
- Provide adequate equipment and activities.
- Follow policies and procedures including disciplinary policies.
- Be familiar with emergency procedures.

SUPERVISE CHILDREN ENROLLED IN THE PROGRAM

- Ensure children are supervised at all times.
- Build children's self esteem.
- Establish routines and provide positive guidance.
- Provide a safe and secure environment for children to feel comfortable.
- Implement positive discipline when required.
- Clearly and effectively communicate in a manner that children understand.

MAINTAIN PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

- Keep parents informed of program expectations, program activities and their child's progress.
- Maintain current, accurate and confidential files and information.
- Carry out daily activity plans.
- Perform other related duties.

The applicant must demonstrate the following personal attributes:

- Maintain strict confidentiality in performing duties of Afterschool staff.
- Be respectful.
- Possess cultural awareness and sensitivity.
- Be flexible.
- Demonstrate strong work ethics.
- Be consistent and fair.
- Be compassionate and understanding.
- Be able to build esteem while ensuring a safe and secure environment.
