<p>Priority Area: <i>Based on the identified focus area, what issue needs to be addressed to achieve the goal?</i> A number of students are not reading on grade-level.</p>	<p>Team Member(s) Responsible: Jeannie Holt Rosalynd Kelleybrew Melissa Edwards Susanna Gann All Literacy Teachers</p>
<p>Desired Outcome: <i>When fully implemented, what will be different as a result of addressing this priority?</i> Students at each grade level will increase reading proficiency by 10% as measured by ATLAS and iReady.</p>	
<p>Root Cause(s): <i>What is the heart of the issue? What evidence supports this conclusion?</i> ATLAS (2024- 2025) results indicate 37% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at the <i>Ready or Exceeding</i> level; therefore, 63% of our students performed below the expected level. iReady (2024-2025) End-of-Year Diagnostic results indicate 47% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at grade level; therefore, 53% of our students performed below the expected level. We need to increase the level of high quality grade level Tier I instruction and Tier II intervention with rigor, intentionality and a sense of urgency.</p>

<p>Desired Outcome: <i>When fully implemented, what will be different as a result of addressing this priority?</i> Students at each grade level will increase math proficiency by 10% as measured by ATLAS and iReady.</p>	
<p>Root Cause(s): ATLAS (2024 - 2025) results indicate 34% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at the <i>Ready</i> or <i>Exceeding</i> level; therefore, 66% performed below the expected level. iReady End-of-Year Diagnostic results indicate 51% of 6th - 8th grade students performed at grade level; therefore, 49% performed below the expected level. We need to increase the level of high quality grade level Tier I instruction and Tier II intervention with rigor, intentionality and a sense of urgency.</p>
