All lockers will be managed by Cupertino High School. Please be aware that there are not enough lockers for everyone, so we encourage students to sign up with a partner. All requests will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis during **Pioneer Days**.

- Students are responsible for providing their own lock, one lock per shared locker.
- Lockers will be chosen online at [Tino Lockers](#).
- Students will have the opportunity to select their lockers on Pioneer Days during the specific timeframe for their grade.
- The locker website will close at the end of each grade-level session.
- **YOU MUST WAIT** until your request is approved before putting a lock on your selected locker.
- If students cannot attend Pioneer Days, the website will open up again on the first day of school.

<h3>AGREEMENT</h3>

- I understand that having a locker on campus is a privilege, not a right and it can be revoked at any time.
- I understand that the school is not responsible for any theft or damage done to items in my locker.
- I am responsible for any damage done to the interior of my locker, including sticker/decal damage.
- I will report all locker problems to the Main Office.
- Any student found using a locker other than the one selected and recorded can have his/her locker privileges revoked and/or face additional Administrative consequences.
- I am responsible for all items kept in my locker at all times, including nights, weekends, and holidays.
- I understand that the school does not provide security for my locker.
- I will not use any other locker than the one I have been assigned.
- I understand my locker is school property and may be searched at anytime.
