BAB: Board Conflict of Interest Policy

Each board member shall abide by all applicable conflict of interest laws contained in North

Dakota statute.

Investigations

In the event that a board policy requires the Board President to conduct an investigation and the

Board President has a conflict of interest, the Board Vice President will conduct the investigation.

If both Board President and Vice President have a conflict of interest, the most senior board

member who does not have a conflict of interest will conduct the investigation. For the purposes

of this paragraph, conflict of interest is defined as a direct and substantial personal or pecuniary

interest.
