FBFB-1: Drop-Outs

Students should be counseled as soon as he/she is detected to be a potential drop-out. When teachers are aware of a student showing drop-out tendencies, they should notify the guidance counselor, principal and parents.

Alternatives to regular attendance should be used as far as they are effective and in accordance with state law in an effort to maintain and further the education of students who find it impossible to attend the regular school session.
