

FDE: Education of Special Education/Disabled Students

The Divide County School District #1 assures that all students with disabilities, ages 3 through 21, have the right to a free and appropriate public education in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and North Dakota law. In addition, the District complies with Section 504 requirements. For the purpose of compliance with state and federal laws concerning special education/disabled students and providing this assurance, the Divide County School District #1 is a member of the Northern Plain Special Education Unit and subscribes to its policies and procedures. These policies and procedures include those required to comply with IDEA and Section 504, such as but not limited to child find and procedural safeguards. For students eligible for services under IDEA, the District will follow procedures for identification, evaluation, placement, and delivery of services to children with disabilities.
