FIA: Student Involvement in Decision Making

Schools at all levels exist so that people attending them can learn. School should provide significant living experiences and decision-making roles in the present, as the best preparation for the future. Involvement of students in student government, surveys of student opinion, and follow-up studies on students are to be encouraged.

The educational institution must respect the rights of students and should encourage the student to exercise by the student of his/ her rights and privileges, that he/she receives practice in being an independent citizen and creative individual, each according to his/ her own capacity.
