FIB: Student Social Events

The School Board believes that social activities in school life assist students in learning how to enjoy worthwhile group events, how to conduct them, and how to contribute to the enjoyment of others. Therefore, school groups and classes may use school facilities to hold social events for their membership. These events may be on a school wide basis or limited to a particular organization.

All events shall be authorized by the principal and shall be under supervision of the principal and staff. Proper chaperoning shall be provided under the direction of the principal.

The following regulations are established to provide proper control and supervision of dances at Divide County High School:

- ✓ Once a student leaves a dance, he may not be readmitted.
- ✓ No one will be admitted to a dance if they are suspected of being under the influence of illegal substances.
- ✓ Proper conduct is required at all times.
- ✓ The chaperons are in charge and must be obeyed at all times.
- ✓ Dances must be scheduled two weeks ahead of time with the Principal's office.
- ✓ Dances are restricted to NTHS students and registered guests.
