GBEE: Mathematics & Science

The Board supports a strong science and mathematics curriculum as vital to quality education. A comprehensive scope and sequence curriculum shall be taught in the natural and physical sciences and mathematics in all grades K- 8.

The high school science and mathematics curriculum shall include courses that will give students a thorough understanding of the fundamentals that are needed for a successful adult life as well as advanced courses for those students who are academically talented and that will adequately prepare students for advanced educational experiences. Arrangements may be pursued with mathematics and science departments of area colleges and universities in the attempt to upgrade and enhance the district offerings.
