

IBCB: Vandalism

Because incidents of willful or malicious abuse, destruction, defacing, and theft of the property of the School District are clearly contrary to the best interests of the School District and injurious to the rights and welfare of the entire community, it will be the policy of the Board to seek all legal redress against persons found to have committed such acts.

Disciplinary action will be taken when students are involved. Full restitution for the damage caused will be sought from the responsible persons, or in the case of minors, from the minors and their parents, under the laws of this state.

The board may offer a reward as authorized by North Dakota law to any person furnishing information leading to the apprehension and conviction of any person (s) approaching or destroying property or equipment belonging to the School District. The Board may also accept private donations to establish a reward fund to encourage the furnishing of such information.
