KAFD: Willful Disruption of School

The Divide County School Board acknowledges that parents, legal guardians and other adults will occasionally misunderstand or disagree with the policies of the school or actions of its employees. The Board expects the staff and administration to deal with such matters in a polite and professional manner. The Board also expects that parents and other adults will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner in their efforts to pursue such matters. A safe and orderly learning environment in which teachers can teach and students can learn must be maintained. The Board, therefore, does not condone having its employees subjected to name calling, defamation of character, threats or coercion of any kind. Adults who violate these standards of conduct shall be instructed to follow these instructions in a proper manner or leave. Should an individual refuse to follow these instructions in a prompt and orderly manner, the superintendent, principal, or designee is authorized to call for police assistance to have the individual removed and charges may be filed for willful disruption of school. Other charges which are applicable may also be filed at the discretion of the administrator.
