KAEA: School Volunteers

Community assistance is solicited in many forms. Room parents, activity supervisors, field trip chaperones, readers with young children, and transportation to special events are a few examples of the many forms of assistance community members may make to the schools.

Letter or other contacts requesting any voluntary assistance must be cleared through the office of the school concerned.

A letter of appreciation or other appropriate recognition should always be given to any member of the community who contributes to the program of the schools.

Building principals may be asked from time to time to provide the Superintendent with a summary of the extent and effect of the use of such volunteers.
