LD: Relations with Community Organizations

Citizens have the responsibility not only to finance the school but also to participate in determining educational goals and objectives that will meet the needs of students in the community. The Board recognizes the community value of the many fine clubs of the city and their contributions to the educational system. The Board and the Superintendent will seek to strengthen and support community groups, cooperating in any way possible to provide information and program material concerning the schools. Principals, teachers and all other staff members are encouraged to take an active part in community life, including contributing their time and talents to organizations and agencies that are interested in the schools and have resources that would enhance the learning program.

These groups will be encouraged to provide:

- 1. Volunteers to assist in the school program on a regular basis or for special events.
- 2. Special resources and materials not available in the regular school budget.
- 3. Volunteers to give special lectures or programs in the school.

Policies governing volunteers in the school and gifts to the school shall be followed.
