




Transportation

All students at Wellington will get a Car Rider hang tag, regardless of regular afternoon transportation.

You should have received a car tag when you checked in this morning.

You will use this to pick up your child today!





Dismissal - Today Only

- Remain in vehicle
- Form car line in parking lot beginning at the front doors.
- Hang new car tag on your mirror so we can identify students. The new car tag replaces having to check IDs.
- Students will be brought out beginning at 11:30 am and 3:00 pm respectively



What are options for my child to get home?

Your child can ride the bus home/daycare, can walk home, or be picked up by car in the car rider line.



wellington.transportation@fayette.kyschools.us explaining the change. Changes must be received in the front office by 1:00 pm.






Can I walk my child to class in the morning?

For the first 3 days, you may escort your child to their classroom. After that, we ask that students be escorted by Wellington staff.

Wellington no longer qualifies for Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the USDA's National School Breakfast and Lunch Program.

Because of this, students will not automatically qualify for free or reduced lunch but will have to apply to receive this status.

Breakfast and Lunch Prices

A healthy breakfast and lunch will be provided to students each day if you would like for them to purchase one.

Breakfast: \$2.00

Lunch: \$2.75

Free and Reduced Lunch

Some families will qualify for free or reduced breakfast and lunch. If your family receives SNAP or KTAP you automatically qualify.


Everyone else that meets eligibility requirements will need to complete an application.

Free and Reduced Lunch Application






Attendance Policy

Students in Fayette County Public Schools are required to attend regularly and punctually the school in which they are enrolled. What do I need to do when my child is absent?

When your child misses school, you will receive an automated phone call notifying you of the absence. You will need to send a note within 3 school days to the front office upon your child's return to school. All absences/tardies will remain unexcused until proper and accepted documentation is received.

Attendance Policy: Unexcused Absences

All absences except those with permissible excuses are unexcused absences.



Attendance Policy: Truancy

Any student who has been absent from school without valid excuse for three days or more, or tardy without valid excuse on three days or more, is considered truant.



Attendance Policy: Tardies

A student is considered tardy if he or she arrives after the designated school start time or leaves before the end of the instructional day.

The first bell rings and 7:40 am and the tardy bell rings when instructions start which is 7:45 am. School dismisses at 2:35 pm.



Consents- Please turn these in at the beginning of the year! Not only do they give me consent to treat your child, the are my source of info about your child's health (allergies, dietary restrictions, pertinent past medical history)

Emergency Action Plan - Needed for students with life threatening allergies, asthma, seizures, diabetes, any other severe medical condition

Medications-

-Daily Meds - need to be given at home if possible (morning and afternoon doses)

All medications need to have current prescription label AND Parent Medication Authorization form filled out. If medication is over the counter (i.e. ibuprofen) must have Physician's Order form completed in addition to Med Authorization form

The school health office only has access to basic treatments-calamine lotion, Bactine antibacterial spray, vaseline, eye wash. OTC medications are not available to be administered.



Fever of 100.4 or above, vomiting*, diarrhea or if it is highly recommended by the nurse

Please keep your child home if they are


sick! FCPS policy states that students need to remain home until free from fever, vomiting, diarrhea for 24 hours without the use of medication.

What is the FRC?


The Family Resource Center is funded through the state government and falls under The Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

The goal of the FRC is to remove any non-academic barriers that may interfere with student learning.




Services Offered through the FRC




Can I donate to the FRC?


