

BJHS 2025-2026 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Tobacco Products, Cigarettes, E-cigarettes, Vapes

The following policy pertains to any student found using or in possession of tobacco products, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapes, and/or any component, part, or accessory for an e-cigarette device or vaping device:

First Offense: 15 Day Alternative Education Placement (DAEP)

Second Offense: 45 Day Alternative Education Placement (DAEP) with the opportunity for a 30 Day Review and referral to Henderson County Pct. 3 for citation.

Dress Code & Policies

No body piercings are allowed except for earrings and a single stud nose piercing on a single nostril.

Shorts are allowed and must extend to at least 3 inches above the knee.

Clothing should be hemmed and if holes are present above the knee skin must not be visible.

Pajama bottoms are not allowed.

House shoes or shoes like house shoes are not permitted.

Hair should be kept to a natural hair color.

Students wearing leggings or yoga pants, must pair them with a shirt or top that is at least fingertip length.

Food and drink items are only allowed in the cafeteria, with the exception of water.

Cell Phone Policy

For safety purposes, the district permits students to possess cell phones; however, cell phones and any other communication devices must remain out of sight in students' backpacks turned off during the school day from 7:53 am – 3:45 pm.

No bluetooth earbuds/headphones allowed

Semester Exam Exemption Policy

In order to qualify for an exemption students must meet the following criteria:

1. Must have outstanding behavior as evidenced by not being placed in ISS, OSS, or DAEP during the semester.
2. Must have outstanding attendance and academic records as follows:
 - For each class, students must have NO MORE than 3 absences (excused or unexcused) and an average of 80 or above for the semester average.
