Expanded Educational Opportunities to Support Student Achievement

During the 2025-2026 school year, the district will establish viable pathways to provide all students with personalized learning experiences, learning opportunities, and support to achieve academic and career goals.

1. Provide support to staff and students through the gradual release model, coaching cycles, colleague observations, the use of data to drive instruction, and instructional rounds to increase student achievement by 5-10% across the content areas.
2. Expand Pre-Advanced and Advanced Placement courses in grades 7-12.
3. Create and Launch a Dual Enrollment Program.
4. Monitor chronic absenteeism, remove barriers, and develop solutions to support students.
5. Develop a Student Ambassador Program.
6. Offer Choice-Based and Focused Professional Development to all staff.
7. Develop a Labor Management Collaborative Institute.

Parent/Guardian and Community Stakeholder Involvement

During the 2025-2026 school year, the district will increase and enhance parent/guardian and community stakeholder involvement by improving communication and collaboration so that the learning environment supports opportunities for student success.

- Create a “Parent Academy” to enhance collaboration with the community and school so that there is a shared experience in learning for families and stakeholders.
- Create and distribute a needs assessment to district families to determine preferred mode (virtual, hybrid, in person), preferred time, and preferred topics.
- Establish and train school parent liaisons.
- Create a Parent Resource Hub.
- Utilize the Climate and Culture survey data to leverage stakeholder voices.

1. Review of the long range facilities plan to prioritize areas of focus.
2. Implementation of our Pre-K Expansion Grant.
