Dear Parents and Guardians,

In accordance with Senate Bill 181, now codified as KRS 160.145, Trigg County Public Schools is committed to maintaining transparency and protecting student safety by notifying families of the digital platforms the district has approved for communication between district employees/volunteers and students.

For the 2025–2026 school year, the Trigg County Board of Education has approved the following platforms:

- ParentSquare – our primary platform for district, school, and classroom communications
- Google Suite for Education – including Gmail, Google Classroom, Google Docs, and related tools used in daily instruction and academic support
- Blackboard and Microsoft Outlook – approved specifically for dual credit instructors who utilize their college/university systems to communicate with students enrolled in those courses

These platforms are monitored and meet all safety and privacy standards required by the Kentucky Department of Education and our local board policies.

Accessing and Reviewing Communications

Parents and guardians can access and review communications through the following methods:

- ParentSquare: Log in via the ParentSquare mobile app or the vendor’s online platform using the email or phone number provided to the school. All messages from the district, school, or teachers are archived and viewable in your ParentSquare account.
- Google Classroom: If your child uses Google Classroom, you can request guardian email summaries, which provide an overview of class activity, assignments, and teacher announcements. Contact your child’s teacher to be added as a guardian.

Access to these platforms must be requested directly through the college or university offering the course, as school-level personnel cannot grant access.
