WHAT IS IT?

Participants meet up four times a year as groups of 6-8 people to enjoy a casual meal at each others' homes, read the Gospel together, and discuss the scriptures.



WHY JOIN?

Live out the Catholic virtue of hospitality by making space for connection, friendship, prayer and breaking of bread. Singles and couples alike are invited to register for the 2025 Sabbath Supper Club season!



WHEN?

Groups meet the third Saturday of October, January, March and May. Your group may also pick another mutually agreed upon day if it works better! All SSC groups are invited to a launch dinner on Monday, Sept. 29 at 6 p.m. in the church gathering space.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is SSC only for married couples?

No it's not! Every person regardless of their marital status or season of life can participate in SSC. It's an opportunity to either meet new people from our parish or reconnect with old friends.

Can I put a SSC group together?

Yes, get a group of friends together! Couples or Singles. We often have the intention to connect with friends ("Let's get together soon"), but we don't (for a variety of reasons). SSC is a way to get dates on the calendar. Just note on the registration the names of those you would like to be in your Sabbath Supper Club group.

I see my friends at school events or at church, what makes Sabbath Supper Club different?

Sabbath Supper Club connects faith, food and friendship! Before dinner, you'll spend some time reading and discussing the Mass readings for the following Sunday. After that, enjoy all aspects of good conversation shared over a meal.

I don't know how to lead a Bible discussion?

You don't have to be a Bible scholar! At the kickoff dinner on September 29, we will walk through how to reflect on the Mass readings.

I'm not able to host eight people in my home. Can I still participate?

Yes! Just note on the form the number of people you're able to welcome into your home.

I'm not a great cook and/or I don't have a lot of time to cook. What type of meal is expected?

Anything from pizza, or a meal made from scratch, or something in between. You can note your culinary skills on the registration form or come to agreement with your SSC group.

What if I can't meet on a third Saturday?

It is suggested that your SSC group gets together four times; on the third Saturday of October, January, March and May, but if Saturday does not work for your group, you can agree to meet on another day.

I'm already busy, how do I make time for this too?

SSC isn't meant to be one more thing on your to-do list. Life is busy, yet when we take time for the most important things - faith & friendship - life is full, not just busy.

I'm a little hesitant to... meet new people OR talk about my faith OR have people in my home OR fill in the blank...

Just take a leap of faith! The purpose of Sabbath Supper Club is to get together to share faith, food and friendship, after all!
