C FACILITIES UPDATE

AUGUST 2025

We've had a busy and productive summer across our district as we continue to invest in safe, welcoming, and functional learning environments for our students, staff, and community.

This summer's work included:

- Routine maintenance, deep cleaning, and general updates (including painting) in all buildings
- Completion of the Copley High School renovation project with Infinity Construction
- Exterior power washing of Copley High School and Copley-Fairlawn Middle School
- Exterior painting at Copley High School, scheduled to conclude in August
- New landscaping design completed for the main entrance at Copley High School
- Parking lot improvements at Copley High School, Arrowhead Primary School, and the Bus Garage. The remaining lots, including expanded parking at all five buildings, are scheduled for next summer.
- Fuel tank replacement at the Bus Garage

Looking ahead, we're actively gathering community input on potential facility upgrades and welcome your ideas and suggestions.
