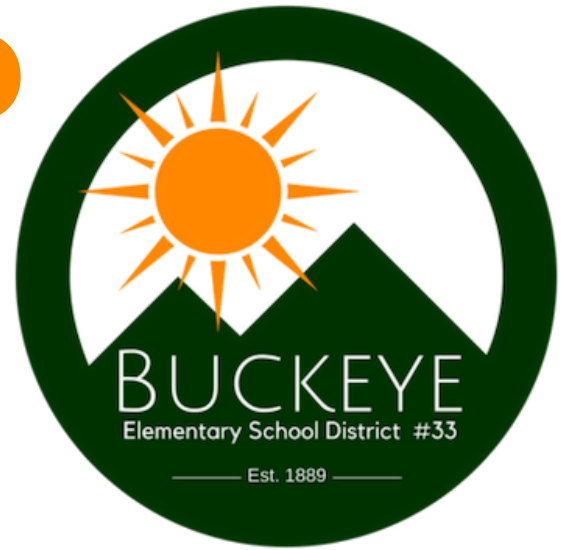

- **Social** – spreading rumors, excluding others, or damaging relationships
- **Cyberbullying** – using technology to harass, threaten, or embarrass someone
