Food Service Account

Free and Reduced-price Meals



Families may qualify for free or reduced-price meals based on the gross income of all household members. Reduced-price breakfasts are \$0.30, lunches are \$0.40. [Apply online](#) through Infinite Campus Parent. Paper forms are also available.

Breakfast



Breakfast is served at all schools every morning to give students fuel to learn.

A variety of choices are available daily.

- Whole grain and protein-rich items such as cereal bars, muffins, pastries, cereal, yogurt, and string cheese.

- Fruit
- 100% fruit juice
- Milk

Students must take 3 items and one must be a fruit or 100% fruit juice.

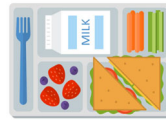

Lunch



School lunches are a balanced meal and a healthy option for all students.

Every lunch includes the following:

- 1 Entrée (*Meat/meat alternate & Grains*)
- 1 Fruit
- 2 Vegetables (*hot and cold*)
- 1 Milk

A variety of fruits & vegetables are offered every day to encourage students to choose foods they like to eat.

Students must choose foods from at least 3 food groups, and one must be a fruit or a vegetable.

How to read the lunch menu

Students have the choice of 3 entrées each day.

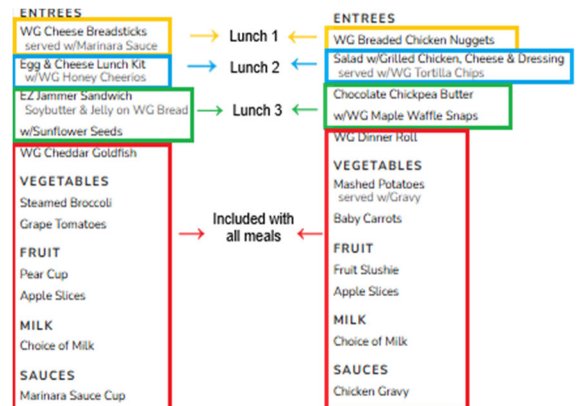
Lunch 1: Listed 1st on the menu (*typically a hot entrée*)

Lunch 2: Listed 2nd on the menu (*gluten-free entrée*)

Lunch 3: Listed 3rd on the menu (*mostly plant based*)

Lunch options change daily, see the monthly menu for the choices offered.
