Directions for NEA Summer Reading BINGO

Summer reading bingo is a game that encourages children to read by completing challenges on a bingo board. Here are some instructions for playing summer reading bingo:

1. Display the board

Display the summer reading bingo board and put it somewhere visible, like on the fridge.

2. Choose an activity

Encourage your child to pick a new activity each read. For example, they could read in a new place, in the bathtub without water, or read a book recommended by a librarian. If they're reading a longer book, they can read the same material over multiple days.

3. Complete challenges

For each challenge, have your child color in or cross off the corresponding square on the board.

4. Win bingo

Set a lofty goal and complete as many squares as possible.

5. Celebrate

Students who bring in their bingo board will be put into a drawing to win Scholastic Dollars to spend at NEA's October Book Fair.
